

ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP

The APODC Scholarship was set up in 2006 to help deaf and hearing impaired children and/or their families to achieve something that is important and relevant to them. The Scholarship is for a maximum amount of \$2,000 and is awarded only once a year.

What does the Scholarship cover?

The Scholarship can be awarded for a wide range of projects, so long as the project supports the purpose of APODC "to champion the quality of life for deaf and hearing impaired children". For example:

- ◆ Attendance at a training course
- ◆ Attendance at a conference or camp (local, national or international)

It does not cover purchase of equipment.

Who can apply?

The Scholarship is open to children who meet all of the following requirements:

- ◆ They are deaf or have a degree of hearing impairment
- ◆ They have not yet left secondary school
- ◆ Their family is a current financial member of APODC and has been so for at least 2 years.

Note:

- ◆ A child can only receive this Scholarship once.
- ◆ This Scholarship is not means tested.

Policy

The final decision of the successful recipient(s) of the APODC Scholarship will be made by the Committee of APODC. All applicants will be notified of the outcome of the final decision. No further correspondence will be entered into.

The successful recipient(s) will be required to:

- ◆ provide a documented report on the Project, and may be requested to present this report to the APODC membership.
- ◆ show his/her support of APODC by assisting at two APODC social events during the year of receipt of Scholarship.
- ◆ use the money for its intended purpose within one year of it being awarded.

The recipient may be required to participate in publicity generated by APODC about the Project.
